**MAP TO CLUB:** The next time you log onto the clubs web site click the **map to club** button, this will take you to a map of where the club is located.

- 1/ Look for the wee orange man at the top left hand corner of the map.
- 2/ There is a brown marker (A) where the club is located on Advance Blvd.
- 3/ When you place your curser on the wee man he will move slightly to the right,
- 4/ Click and hold the left hand button on your mouse drag the wee man over to the (A) marker.
- 5/ As you drag it over two things are going to happen.
  - (a) a little circle will appear below the wee man.
  - (b) the streets will be high lighted in blue.
- 6/ Now place the little circle over the (A) marker, when you do that a little picture will appear now release the left click button.
- 7/ You will now see the office building on the other side of the street from the club.
- 8/ Several things can now be done
  - (a) Place your mouse curser on the road you will see a horizontal line with two arrow directions and a transparent circle.
  - (b) Left click your mouse button and hold it on the transparent circle you will now be able to move the image left or right in a 360degree direction you can also move the image vertically up or down.
  - (c) The horizontal line with arrows when you click on the arrow or further down the line the image will move horizontally to where you clicked it to.
  - (d) You can also use the buttons on the top left corner of the image to do the same a, b, c and d.
- 9/ At the top of the page you can see GOOGLE maps, type in the address of your street then try the address where you grew up. NOW not all streets have been mapped yet. I went to the street I lived in Leith and it is still the same except for more cars and Leith is still the Beverly Hills of Edinburgh..... In my opinion.
